1 Apply online through the Common Application or the Goucher Transfer Application. No application fee!

2 Submit the following supplemental materials:

- Essay or personal statement (not required for Goucher Transfer Application)
- Official college transcript(s) from all colleges attended
- Foreign transcript evaluation (see website for more details)
- Recommendation letter from a professor or former teacher (not required for Goucher Transfer Application)
- Official final high school transcript (for applicants applying with fewer than 30 credits)

GOUCHER TRANSFER GUARANTEE

Transfer with confidence, knowing that your gen ed and foreign language credits will be accepted. Additionally, all Goucher transfers are automatically offered guaranteed scholarships based on their cumulative GPA.

All admitted students are automatically considered for Merit Scholarships of up to \$31,000 per year. Additional awards are available for students who have completed an associate degree, are members of Phi Theta Kappa, or are part of an honors-guaranteed admission articulation agreement.
